Bursary Information

Background:

William A.D. "Bill" Trent was born in Saint John, N.B. on November 23, 1905. He grew up in the Port City and received his education in area schools. He married Florence Thelma Ullock on July 16, 1959. The Trents had no children. At his retirement, Bill was employed with the Government of Canada as Manager of the Unemployment Insurance Commission in Moncton.

He petitioned Keith Lodge No. 23 for membership and was Initiated October 23, 1945; Passed November 22, 1945 and Raised December 21, 1945. He affiliated with Acacia Lodge No. 49 as a Charter Member on August 26, 1946 and assumed the Master's Chair in 1952. He was a Past Senior Grand Deacon of the Grand Lodge of New Brunswick. A much travelled Mason, Bill was well liked and respected by the brethren.

It was his wish to create a charitable education trust as a memorial to his late wife Thelma, and at his death, to himself as well. This trust, hereafter known as the "Trent Memorial Scholarship Fund", is a Registered Charitable Scholarship Trust. Donations may be made to the fund and receipts will be issued for income tax purposes.

Purpose:

To assist young men and women pursuing a post-secondary school education at any qualified Canadian university or school of higher education.

Basis of Awards:

There will be provided annually a bursary to each of two worthy applicants. Worthiness will be assessed from the following qualifying factors:

- (i) Financial need
- (ii) Residency within New Brunswick
- (iii) Good character and scholastic achievement

Selection of Applicants:

Preference will be given wherever possible to Canadian graduating high school students who are the children or grandchildren of past or present members of Keith Lodge No. 23 or Acacia Lodge No. 49, both in Moncton, N.B. The selection of awards shall be vested in the Trustees and made without distinction for class, creed, religion, sex, or other discriminatory factors. Applications must be forwarded in time to reach the Secretary of either Keith Lodge No. 23 or Acacia Lodge No. 49, or any Trustee, not later than the CLOSING DATE - July 15th.
